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
1. TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS AND CARE

1.1 Receiving, handling and use instructions

• Check that the product has arrived in good condition and, in case of any discrepancy or damage, contact the supplier promptly.



• It is advisable to line the floor before attaching the feet or base to prevent damage to the product.



• Avoid hitting and resting the product on sharp objects.



• Avoid sitting on the armrests and backrests and jumping on the chair.





• Do not use the product as a support or ladder.



• Move the product by lifting both ends with the help of another person and position it in the desired location.



• Do not drag, pull, or lift only one side of the product to move it.






1.2 Storage and transportation instructions

- Avoid stacking other items under the product during storage.
- Check the labels attached to the product and present on the packaging. They contain instructions on stacking and storage.



Example of guidance on the packaging/box.

- Position the packaging according to the orientation indicated by the arrows to avoid damaging the structure.
- Respect the stacking limit if you need to stack the product for transportation.
- Don't stack boxes of different sizes, as the strongest parts of them are the edges and corners.
- When stacking two boxes, it is crucial that they are both the same size and are placed in line with each other to form a straight column.

2. LEGS AND BASES

If the armchair has separate feet or a base, the following instructions illustrate the correct way to attach them.

2.2 Legs

Attach the feet by screwing them to the underside of the armchair.

2.2 Bases

Fit the base into the bottom of the armchair and fix it with the screws in the holes as in the model.




Armchair with base and how to attach it.



2.2.1 Adjustable feet

Some armchairs have height-adjustable feet on their base so that the product remains aligned and stable even on uneven surfaces. To make this adjustment, look for the feet at each end of the base's support and move them in a circular pattern.




Highlighted adjustable feet.

• If you have difficulty turning the feet because they are too tight, use pliers to help you turn them for the first time. Then, you can adjust the feet without tools.

2.2.2 Swivel base

Some armchairs shipped with a separate swivel base have a spring that allows the backrest to move. The spring can be identified by looking at the base at eye level. This spring must be fitted correctly so that the backrest moves only backward and maximizes the armchair's comfort.






The arrow indicates the correct direction for installing the swivel base.

• For this type of base, an arrow sticker is attached to the base; following the direction of this arrow when attaching the base of the product will provide the correct direction for the spring.



3. HOW TO MEASURE YOUR ARMCHAIR

To measure the product, consider the two most extreme points to determine the length and depth. In the case of the round armchairs, use a straight object to project the most extreme points of the product and make it easier to measure.

If you are still determining the correct measurement position, always consult the sketches in the datasheets, observe each product's measurements, and follow the indicated directions.





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
